



RING SIZING CHART

Ring sizing can be tricky, especially when ordering online & you can't try the ring on. Rings that are flat along the top are sometimes too tight when you order them in your size. Even if you've had your size measured at the jeweler, measuring tools can differ from each other.

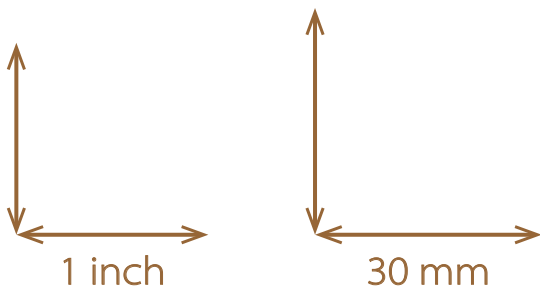
Normally, a ring should be a little bit difficult to slide over your knuckle but fit comfortably loose on the finger. Temperature can also affect how a ring fits (fingers tend to swell in warm weather). Keep in mind that ring sizes can vary between your left and right hand even on the same finger!

If you are between ring sizes, I suggest you order a half-size larger. It is easier to make a ring smaller.

To make sizing easier, I've included my ring sizer, which is calibrated to my measuring tools. Please follow the instructions below.

1 Print out this PDF on letter-size paper at 100%.

2 Check the size of the horizontal and vertical lines using a ruler to make sure it printed properly.



3 Take a ring that fits comfortably and place on top of the circles until you find a perfect match. If one size is a bit too small, go with the next size up.

4 Double-check your measurements!
